



Chiang Mai Rajabhat University Announcement
on
Guidelines for Prevention of the Spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019
(COVID-19) (No.2)

With reference to the announcement of the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation on Measures and Vigilance against the Spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) (No.9), dated on 2nd January 2021, the higher education institutions and the departments in the ministry are required to proceed the measures and guidelines for prevention of the spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). Pursuant to the situation regarding the number of the detection of infected patients with Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) is constantly increasing in many provinces in Thailand, the Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration (CCSA) has designated the infected risk provinces as: maximum controlled areas (red zone), controlled areas (orange zone), areas under high surveillance (yellow zone), and areas under surveillance (green zone) (updated information on 3rd January 2021) and the Order of Chiang Mai Communicable Disease Committee No. 1/2564 on Measures and Vigilance against the Spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) in Chiang Mai, announced on 4th January, 2021.

Therefore, for preventing the spread of new wave of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) and for the safety of faculty members, staff, and students of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University who probably traveled to hometown or other places during the New Year's Holiday, Chiang Mai Rajabhat University hereby issues the following announcement as follows:

1. Do not use any buildings or other places located in Chiang Mai for teaching or doing any activities from Wednesday, 6th January 2021 to Sunday, 24th January 2021.
2. All courses for students are required to be conducted as follows:
 - 2.1 Proceeding teaching in the form of online format.
 - 2.2 Faculty members can consider the appropriate midterm exam administration in each subject by not using university buildings in exam administration.

- 2.3 For internship, faculties and/or entrepreneurs can consider the form of appropriate internship program.
3. The head sectors assign staff to work from home as appropriate and the staff are required to report working reports to the head sectors regularly by strictly follow this announcement.
 4. In case that it is necessary that faculty members and staff have to transport/travel to the high risk areas according to the Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration or as province designation, reporting to the head sectors and following this announcement is strictly required.
 5. If having any related problems/issues, the administrators of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University are required to prepare and closely monitor the situation continually, and the report should be immediately reported to the president.
 6. In cases where there is a problem of following this announcement, the President shall have the final decision.

Please kindly be informed and strictly follow accordingly.
