

Chiang Mai Rajabhat University Announcement

on

Guidelines for Teaching and Examination in the 2nd Semester of Academic Year 2020 in Respond to Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Outbreak

With reference to the university's announcement on Measures for Prevention of the Spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) announced on 21st December 2020, (No.2), on 5th January 2021, and (No.3) on 8th January 2021, Pursuant to the situation regarding the new wave of coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) outbreak in Chiang Mai has continually improved with no report of new COVID-19 cases from 13rd to 22nd January 2021. Therefore, Chiang Mai Rajabhat University hereby issues the announcement, and it is required to follow the guidelines:

- 1. Faculty members, staff, and students are required to constantly follow the announcement of the university, the Chiang Mai Communicable Disease Committee, and the Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration (CCSA).
- 2. Faculty members can teach and administer final examinations in classrooms. Faculty members can consider an appropriate form of hybrid instruction by combining in-class and online instructions for each subject from 25th January 2021 onwards. It is required to strictly follow the measures for prevention of the spread of COVID-19 of the Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration (CCSA).
- 3. Faculty members, staff, and students who traveled from the maximum controlled areas (28 provinces) as designated by the Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration (CCSA) are required to follow the Order of Chiang Mai Communicable Disease Committee No. 9/2564 on Measures for the control of people traveling to Chiang Mai Provincial Area, announced on 10th January, 2021 or any related announcement. For faculty members and staff, it is required to report the information to the head sectors immediately; for students, it is required to report the information to the advisors immediately, and to quarantine (Home Quarantine) for 14 days.

4. The administrators of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University are required to prepare and closely monitor the situation continually. If having any related problems/issues, the report should be immediately reported to the president.

5. In cases where there is a problem of following this announcement, the president shall have the final decision.

This announcement takes an affect from now on, or until further notice.
