

Chiang Mai Rajabhat University Announcement

or

Guidelines for Prevention of the Spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) (No.4)

According to the report of Coronavirus Diseases (COVID-19) outbreak situation by the Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration, Ministry of Public Health, and the report of Chiang Mai Data Center and Chiang Mai Communicable Disease Committee regarding the new wave outbreak of Coronavirus Diseases (COVID-19) in Chiang Mai and many provinces in Thailand. During Songkran festival, students, faculty members, and staff of university probably transport/travel to their hometown located in high risk areas. The order of Chiang Mai Communicable Disease Committee No. 1/2564 on the Measures for Prevention and control of the Spread of Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) in Chiang Mai Province Areas, announced on 4th January 2021 and the additional orders.

Therefore, to prevent the spread of new wave of Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) and for the safety of students, faculty members, and staff of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University who probably transport/travel to their hometown or other areas during Songkran festival, Chiang Mai University hereby issues the announcement as follows:

- 1. Do not use any buildings located in Chiang Mai for teaching and doing any activities temporarily from Saturday, 10th April 2021 to Sunday, 18th April 2021.
- 2. To conduct teaching for students, regular program students, special program students, and graduate students, it is required to follow the Chiang Mai Rajabhat University Announcement on Guidelines for Teaching and Examination in Summer Semester, Academic Year 2020 during Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Outbreak Situation, announced on 9th April 2021.
- 3. The head sectors assign staff to work from home as appropriate and the staff are required to report working reports to the head sectors regularly by strictly follow this announcement.
- 4. In case that faculty members and staff have to transport/ travel to the high risk areas according to the Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration as province designation, they are required to report to the head sectors and follow this announcement strictly.
- 5. The administrators of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University are required to prepare and closely monitor the situation continually. If having any related problems/issues, the report should be immediately reported to the president.

6. In cases where there is a problem of following this announcement, the President shall have the final decision.

Please kindly be informed and strictly follow this announcement until further notice.
