

Chiang Mai Rajabhat University Announcement

Guidelines for Teaching and Examination in Academic Year 2020 during Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Outbreak Situation

According to the report of Coronavirus Diseases (COVID-19) outbreak situation by the Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration, Ministry of Public Health, and the report of Chiang Mai Data Center and Chiang Mai Communicable Disease Committee regarding the new wave outbreak of Coronavirus Diseases (COVID-19) in Chiang Mai and many provinces in Thailand. During Songkran festival, students, faculty members, and staff of university probably transport/travel to their hometown located in high risk areas.

Therefore, to conduct teaching and examination in 2nd semester of International College and summer semester in academic year 2020 of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University effectively and to reduce the risk of the spread of Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19), Chiang Mai Rajabhat University hereby issues this announcement and it is required to practice as follows:

- 1. To conduct teaching in 2nd semester of International College and summer semester in academic year 2020 in the form of online in all courses by covering all contents, competency, and learning outcomes of each course. If it is necessary to conduct teaching in other forms, the Dean will consider as appropriate by following the measures and guidelines for prevention of the spread of Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) strictly.
- 2. For final examination in 2nd semester of International College and mid term and final examination in summer semester in academic year 2020, the instructors can change the form of evaluation and assessment in other forms as appropriate in each course and do not administer the exam in classroom.
- 3. The student internship programs shall be considered by faculty/college and/or entrepreneur company as appropriate for preventing the spread of Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19).
