



**Chiang Mai Rajabhat University Announcement**  
**on**  
**Guidelines for Conducting Teaching in the 1<sup>st</sup> Semester in Academic Year 2021**  
**during Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Outbreak Situation**

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According to the reports by the Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration and Ministry of Public Health regarding the new wave outbreak of Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) situation in many areas, and some students probably transport/travel to their hometown in many provinces which located in high risk areas during the summer break in academic year 2020.

In order to conduct teaching in the 1<sup>st</sup> semester in academic year 2021 effectively and to reduce the risk of the spread of Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19), the university committee meeting No. 6/2021 dated on 25<sup>th</sup> May 2021 agrees to announce the Guidelines for Conducting Teaching in the 1<sup>st</sup> Semester in Academic Year 2021 during Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Outbreak Situation as follows:

1. To conduct teaching in the form of online in all courses from 21<sup>st</sup> June 2021 – 24<sup>th</sup> August 2021 by covering contents, competency, and learning outcome of each course as follows:
  - 1.1 For lecture courses, lecturers can choose to use tools/programs supporting learning online for motivating students' learning appropriately.
  - 1.2 For laboratory courses, lecturers can change/modify to other substitute teaching format as appropriate or postpone lab teaching after 24<sup>th</sup> August 2021.
  - 1.3 For internship/cooperative education training courses, it is required to be conducted as follows:
    - 1.3.1 To adjust the teaching form to other forms as appropriate.
    - 1.3.2 In case that the entrepreneurs are well-prepared and have measures for prevention and control the spread of Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19), faculties/colleges might consider sending students for the internship/cooperative education training by require students to inform their intention in writing as the informed consent or the willingness to practice form for internship/cooperative education training at that company.
    - 1.3.3 To postpone internship/cooperative education training by considering changing study plan as appropriate.

2. Lecturers can consider the form of online teaching as follows:
  - 2.1 Live teaching platform, allowing interaction among teachers and students by using Microsoft Teams by download the manual via <http://www.lms.cmru.ac.th/> and select the topic “download manual and related documents”.
  - 2.2 Online Virtual Classroom by using Google Classroom for checking student attendance, assigning assignment, sharing data for teaching and lecturing, and related documents for students.
  - 2.3 Self-study can be done by students via E-learning lesson or additional study from video clips or review contents or do exercises as assigned in learning management system (LMS) by CMRU Moodle LMS program.
3. Mid-term examination in the 1<sup>st</sup> semester in academic year 2021, and the mid-term, final, and summer examination in academic year 2020 of International College, lecturers can consider modifying the form of learning measurement and assessment, form of assignment, or reports as substitution to administration of examination in classroom. Lecturers are required to inform students in the first day of class regarding the form of learning measurement and assessment.
4. In case of Comprehensive examination/qualifying examination or concept paper/thesis/independent study defense examination in graduate programs, online platform or integrated online meeting system can be practiced.
