

Chiang Mai Rajabhat University Announcement on

Guidelines for Conducting Teaching and Learning in the Summer Semester of Academic Year 2021 During Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Outbreak Situation

In order to conduct teaching and learning in the summer semester of Academic Year 2021 effectively and to reduce the risk of the spread of Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19), the academic administration committee meeting no.2/2565, dated on 25th February 2022 agrees to announce the guidelines for conducting teaching and learning in the summer semester of academic year 2021 during Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) outbreak situation as follows:

- 1. To conduct teaching and learning in the form of online or on-site or hybrid learning by combining online and on-site classroom as appropriate in each course by covering contents, competency, and learning outcomes of each course as follows:
- 1.1 For lecture courses, lecturers can choose to use tools/programs supporting online learning for motivating students learning appropriately. In case of conducting teaching in the classroom, the number of students cannot exceed the seats specified by the university and it is required to follow the measures for prevention of the spread of COVID-19 of the Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration (CCSA) strictly.
- 1.2 For laboratory courses, practical teaching using specialized tools, lecturers conduct teaching in the laboratory room which designated in the class schedule, each section cannot exceed 25 students and must follow the procedures for using laboratory strictly.
- 1.3 For internship/cooperative education training courses, it is required to be conducted as follows:
- 1.3.1 In case that the entrepreneurs are well-prepared and have measures for prevention and control the spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), faculties/colleges

might consider sending students for the internship/cooperative education training by requiring students to inform their intention in writing as the informed consent or willingness to do internship /cooperative education training at that entrepreneur.

- 1.3.2 To adjust internship/cooperative education training to other forms as appropriate.
- 1.3.3 To postpone internship/cooperative education training by considering changing study plan as appropriate.
 - 2. Lectures can consider the form of online teaching as follows:
- 2.1 Live teaching platform, allowing interaction among teachers and students by using Microsoft Teams. The manual can be downloaded via http://www.lms.cmru.ac.th/ with the topic "download manual and related documents".
- 2.2 Self-study can be done by students via E-learning lesson or additional study from video clips or review contents or do exercises as assigned in learning management system (LMS) by CMRU Moodle LMS program.
- 3. Mid-term and final examination in the summer semester of academic year 2021, lecturers can consider administering in the form of online or on-site and it is required to inform students in the first day of class by concerning the students benefits as primary and following the measures for prevention of the spread of COVID-19 of the Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration (CCSA) strictly.
- 4. In case of Comprehensive examination/ qualifying examination or concept paper/thesis/independent study defense examination in graduate programs, online platform or integrated online meeting system can be practiced.

This announcement was made for conducting teaching and examination of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University educational administration in Chiang Mai province area.
