2. Eligibility of Applicants

- 2.1 Applicants must be the age over 18 years old.
- 2.2 Applicants must complete high school or equivalent from schools/educational institutes located in the country where applicants holding nationality.
- 2.3 Applicants must have basic Thai language skills in listening, speaking, and reading.
- 2.4 Applicants must not be a monk or novice.
- 2.5 Applicants must be in good health and must not have any diseases that will obstruct their studies.
- 2.6 Applicants must be well-behaved.

3. Conditions of the Scholarships

- 3.1 Scholarship recipients will be granted in the form of tuition fee and international student fee waivers in regular semesters during the period of study program (4 academic years). Scholarship recipients shall responsible for other expenses, such as student entrance fee, damage deposit fee, accommodation fee, cost of living, health and accident insurance fee, etc.
- 3.2 Scholarship recipients are not eligible to apply for other scholarships unless having permission from the university.
- 3.3 Scholarship recipients must have grade point average (GPA) not less than 2.50 in each academic year during the period of granted scholarship. In case that GPA is lower than the required criteria, scholarship recipients would not be granted the scholarship in the next academic year.
- 3.4 Scholarship recipients must assist university activities for 5 hours per semester in Students Development Division and assist faculty/department/section activities at least 10 hours per semester.
- 3.5 Scholarship recipients are required to stay at the university dormitory for 1 academic year. .
- 3.6 Scholarship recipients are required to prepare tools and equipment for learning online.

4. Terminations of the Scholarships

- 4.1 Scholarship recipients disclaim the scholarship.
- 4.2 The student status of scholarship recipients has been terminated by the university order due to misconduct or misbehavior or grade point averages not meet the conditions of scholarships.
- 4.3 Scholarship recipients change study program from granted scholarship program to other programs.
- 4.4 Scholarship recipients have health conditions or diseases that will obstruct their studies.
- 4.5 Scholarship recipients do not follow the conditions of the scholarships.
- 4.6 Scholarship recipients provided incorrect, false, or misleading information.

5. Programs Offered, Number of Scholarships, and Specific Requirements

Applicants can review the available fields of study, the number of scholarship, and the specific requirements for each field of study. This information is provided in the attached at the end of the announcement.

6. Application Process

6.1 Send required documents to email iao@g.cmru.ac.th

The required documents for application are as follows:

- 1) High school transcript or high school diploma/certificate or equivalent transcript in other languages must be translated into English with an official stamp.
- 2) 1-inch official photograph
- 6.2 Applicants shall identify two chosen study programs.

7. Selection Criteria

The university will consider and select the applicants from high school records/score/grade point average, and the interviews.

8. Announcement of Selected Applicants

The university will announce the selected applicants on April 3, 2024 via https://mss.cmru.ac.th
(In case that any study programs cannot be offered, the final decision shall be determined by the university.)

9. Confirmation of the Scholarships

The selected applicants must confirm to accept scholarships and send the scan of documents according to the required documents no.5 to email: iao@g.cmru.ac.th during April 4-25, 2024. In case that applicant cannot confirm within the deadline, it will be considered that the applicants disclaim the scholarships.
