2. Qualifications of Applicants

2.1 General Qualification

2.1.1 Doctoral Degree

1) Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree or the equivalent with an excellent grade; or a Master's degree or the equivalent. Applicants must have the requirement of the English language proficiency standard test according to the Announcement of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University.

2) Applicants must have other qualifications in accordance with the regulation of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University regarding the Graduate Studies, 2018.

2.1.2 Master Degree

1) Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree or the equivalent, and meet the program qualification with the committees' consideration. Applicants must have the requirement of the English language proficiency standard test according to the Announcement of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University.

2) Applicants must have other qualifications in accordance with the regulation of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University regarding the Graduate Studies, 2018.

2.2 Program Qualifications

2.2.1 Doctoral Degree

1) Doctor of Philosophy Program in Science for Sustainable Local Development

Applicants must hold a Master's degree or the equivalent. Applicants must have the requirement of the English language proficiency standard test according to the Announcement of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University.

2) Doctor of Philosophy Program in Community Energy and Environment

Plan 1 Type 1.1

Applicants must hold a Master's degree or the equivalent in a related field or having experience at least 2 years in energy and environment or a related field.

Plan 2 Type 2.1

Applicants must hold a Master's degree or the equivalent in a related field.

3) Doctor of Education Program in Educational Administration

1) Applicants must hold a Master's degree in education or a related field of education.

2) Applicants must have an experience in educational administration educational or institution administration with the position not lower than supervisor level not less than 2 years or as an administrator/lecturer in higher education institutions.

4) Doctor of Education Program in Educational Administration (Mae Hong Son Campus)

Applicants must hold a Master's degree in education or a related field of education, and must have the requirement of the English language proficiency standard test

according to the Announcement of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University.

Plan 1 Type 1.1

Must have research experience of not less than 1 year or have publications. There is no need to take the course EA 7101 Research Methodology and Advanced Statistics in Educational Administration. As for the seminar course in educational administration, students are required to present progress reports three times.

2.2.2 Master Degree

1) Master of Education Program in Learning Management Science

Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree in education or the equivalent in any discipline certified by the Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC).

2) Master of Science Program in Science Teaching

Type 1 Non – Educational Professional License

Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree in sciences, or applied sciences with the field of Physics, Chemistry, Biology, general science or applied sciences.

Type 2 Educational Professional License

Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree in sciences with the field of Physics, Chemistry, Biology, general science or applied sciences.

3) Master of Science Program in Community Energy and Environment

Plan A Type A1

Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree or the equivalent in a related field with GPAX scores (8 semesters) more than 3.25. Applicants must have experience at least 2 years in energy and environment or a related field.

Plan A Type A2

Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree or the equivalent in a related field.

4) Master of Science Program in Management Innovation in Agricultural and Food Enterprise

Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree or the equivalent in any field of study certified by the Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC).

5) Master of Public Health Program in Community Health System Management

- Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree or the equivalent in public health or health sciences fields certified by the Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC).

- In the case of graduation with a Bachelor's degree in other fields that are not related to health sciences, applicants must have working experiences at least 3 years in public health or related to health in all dimensions with the consideration of the Administrative Committee of the Master of Public Health Program in Community Health System Management.

6) Master of Public Health Program (Mae Hong Son Campus)

Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree or the equivalent in fields related to community public health, public health sciences, health sciences, or related disciplines such as medicine, pharmacy, nursing, and medical technology, or individuals with relevant work experience in health-related fields.

7) Master of Arts Program in English Language Studies

Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree or the equivalent in any field of study certified by the Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC). Applicants must have the requirement of the English language proficiency standard test according to the program committees' consideration or 480 scores up for TOEFL (ITP) or 50 scores up for TOEFL (iBT) or and 5.0 scores up for IELTS or 600 scores up for TOEIC or 65 scores up for CMRU-TEP or B2 level for CEFR

8) Master of Arts Program in Science for Sustainable Local Development

Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree or the equivalent in any field of study.

9) Master of Business Administration Program in Business Administration

Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree or the equivalent in any field of study, and must have requirement of the English language proficiency standard test according to the announcement of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University.

3. Application

Qualified applicants who meet the requirements may apply online and upload the certified required documents through the Graduate School website <http://www.graduate.cmru.ac.th> from March 4, 2024 – May 15, 2024.

Required Documents:

- 1) 1 Photograph (not more than 2 Mb.) (jpeg)
- 2) 1 Transcript in Thai or English (.pdf)
- 3) 1 Copies of National identification card or passport (.pdf)
- 4) 1 Certified copy of name/surname change certificate (if any) (.pdf)
- 5) 1 English proficiency official report (if any) (.pdf)

If applicants have English proficiency test scores that are not more than 2 years old from the date of score reporting until the application date, and the scores must not be lower than those specified in the table below, they should submit their English proficiency test scores to the Graduate School, Chiang Mai Rajabhat University, 13th Floor, Rajabhat Memorial Building, Chiang Mai Rajabhat University (Wieng Bua Center), to exempt from registering for English language courses at the doctoral level. This is also to exempt from the basic English language knowledge test at the master's level (as stated in item 8), and to register for English language courses as prescribed by the university.

5. Admission examination

Admission examination will be held on May 18, 2024, 9 a.m. at Chiang Mai Rajabhat University (Chiang Mai Campus – Wieng Bua Center) and Chiang Mai Rajabhat University (Mae Hong Son Campus).

6. Announcement of examination results

7. Online Record of Personal Information

Eligible candidates must record the personal information, and print out from the Office of Registrar website <http://www.reg.cmru.ac.th> from May 23 – 25, 2024.

8. Fundamental Course Test (For Master Degree)

Test date : May 25, 2024

Those Master's degree students must take a Fundamental Course Test which providing writing and practical section at Chiang Mai Rajabhat University (Chiang Mai Campus – Wieng Bua Center), and must pay the test fee 400 Baht per course before the test date. (For examination details and payment fee will be announced later.)

Remark: Examiners who fail or absent the Fundamental Course Test must enroll in the Fundamental Course according to the rules of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University.

9. Submission of the Required Documents

Eligible candidates must submit the following required documents on May 25, 2024 from 9 a.m. – 4 p.m. at the Graduate School office, Chiang Mai Rajabhat University (Chiang Mai Campus – Wieng Bua Center) and Chiang Mai Rajabhat University (Mae Hong Son Campus).

- 1) 1 photographs (1 or 1.5 Inches size)
- 2) 2 copies of degree certificate
- 3) 2 copies of transcript in Thai or English
- 4) 1 copies of house registration
- 5) 2 copies of copies of national identification card or passport
- 6) 2 copies of certified copy of name/surname change certificate (if any)
- 7) 1 Letter of Consent to Disclose Information
- 8) 1 English proficiency official report (if any)

If eligible candidates have English proficiency test scores that are not more than 2 years old from the date of score reporting until the date of student registration, and the scores must not be lower than those specified in item 3, eligible candidates should submit English proficiency test scores to the Graduate School.

10. Payment of Registration and Other Tuition Fees

Students must pay registration fees and other tuition fees from May 28 – 31, 2024 via the following payment methods:

- 1) Pay via Mobile Banking Applications of all banks by scanning the barcode in the payment slip, or
- 2) Pay at all branches of banks and Counter Services located inside Thailand.


