2. Qualifications of Applicants

2.1 General Qualification

2.1.1 Doctoral Degree

- 1) Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree or the equivalent with an excellent grade; or a Master's degree or the equivalent or currently be enrolled in a master's degree or equivalent program and expected to graduate before the beginning of the first semester of the academic year 2026, and meet the program qualification. Applicants must have the requirement of the English language proficiency standard test according to the Announcement of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University.
- 2) Applicants must have other qualifications in accordance with the regulation of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University regarding the Graduate Studies, 2018 and/or any subsequent amendments.

2.1.2 Master Degree

- 1) Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree or the equivalent or currently be enrolled in a bachelor's degree or equivalent program and expected to graduate before the beginning of the first semester of the academic year 2026, and meet the program qualification
- 2) Applicants must have other qualifications in accordance with the regulation of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University regarding the Graduate Studies, 2018 and/or any subsequent amendments.

2.2 Program Qualifications

2.2.1 Doctoral Degree

1) Doctor of Philosophy Program in Science for Sustainable Local Development

Applicants must hold a Master's degree or the equivalent. Applicants must have the requirement of the English language proficiency standard test according to the Announcement of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University.

2) Doctor of Philosophy Program in Community Energy and Environment

Plan 1 Type 1.1

Applicants must hold a Master's degree or the equivalent in a related field or having experience at least 2 years in energy and environment or a related field.

Plan 2 Type 2.1

Applicants must hold a Master's degree or the equivalent in a related field.

3) Doctor of Philosophy in Business Administration

Plan 1.1

- Applicants must hold a Master's degree or equivalent in a field related to Business Administration from a higher education institution accredited by the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation (MHESI). The Master's degree GPA must be no less than 3.00.
- Applicants must have at least 2 years of work experience in research or possess demonstrable achievements in the field of Business Administration.
- Applicants who do not meet the above qualifications may be considered at the discretion of the Program Committee and in accordance with the university's admission announcement.

Plan 2.1

- Applicants must hold a Master's degree in any field from a higher education institution accredited by the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation (MHESI). The Master's degree GPA must be no less than 3.00.
- Applicants must have at least 1 year of work experience in a public or private organization.
- Applicants who do not meet the above qualifications may be considered at the discretion of the Program Committee and in accordance with the university's admission announcement.

4) Doctor of Education Program in Educational Administration

- Applicants must hold a Master's degree in education or a related field of education. Applicants must have the requirement of the English language proficiency standard test according to the Announcement of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University.
- Applicants must have an experience in educational administration educational or institution administration with the position not lower than supervisor level not less than 2 years or as an administrator/lecturer in higher education institutions.

2.2.2 Master Degree

1) Master of Education Program in Educational Administration

- Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree in education or a related field of education.
- Applicants must have working experiences at least 2 years in educational institution or educational institution.

2) Master of Education Program in Learning Management Science

Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree in education or the equivalent in any discipline certified by the Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC).

3) Master of Science Program in Science Teaching

<u>Type 1 Non – Educational Professional License</u>

Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree in sciences, or applied sciences with the field of Physics, Chemistry, Biology, General Science or Applied Sciences.

Type 2 Educational Professional License

Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree in sciences with the field of Physics, Chemistry, Biology, General Science or Applied Sciences.

4) Master of Science Program in Community Energy and Environment

Plan A Type A1

Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree or the equivalent in a related field with GPAX scores (8 semesters) not less than 3.25. Applicants must have experience at least 2 years in energy and environment or a related field.

Plan A Type A2

Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree or the equivalent in a related field.

5) Master of Science in Computer Technology and Learning Innovation

- Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree or the equivalent in Computer Education, Information Technology, Computer Science, Computer Engineering, or other related fields, or

- Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree or the equivalent and have at least one year of work experience related to computers or information technology, with a certificate of employment from the current workplace or from a previous employer.

- Applicants must have other qualifications in accordance with the announcements of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University.

6) Master of Public Health Program in Community Health System Management

- Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree or the equivalent in public health or health sciences fields certified by the Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC).
- In the case of graduation with a Bachelor's degree in other fields that are not related to health sciences, applicants must have working experiences at least 3 years in public health or related to health in all dimensions with the consideration of the Administrative Committee of the Master of Public Health Program in Community Health System Management.

7) Master of Arts Program in English Language Studies

Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree or the equivalent in any field of study certified by the Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC). Applicants must have the requirement of the English language proficiency standard test according to the program committees' consideration or 480 scores up for TOEFL (ITP) or 50 scores up for TOEFL (IBT) or and 5.0 scores up for IELTS or 600 scores up for TOEFC or 65 scores up for CMRU-TEP or 82 level for CEFR

- 8) Master of Arts Program in Science for Sustainable Local Development
 Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree or the equivalent in any field of study.
- 9) Master of Business Administration Program in Business Administration

Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree or the equivalent in any field of study, and must have requirement of the English language proficiency standard test according to the announcement of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University.

3. Application

Qualified applicants who meet the requirements may apply online and upload the certified required documents through the Graduate School website www.graduate.cmru.ac.th between Monday, November 3, 2025, and Monday, January 26, 2026.

If applicants have English proficiency test scores that are not more than 2 years old from the date of score reporting until the application date, and the scores <u>must not be lower than</u> those specified in the table below, they should submit their English proficiency test scores to the Graduate School, Chiang Mai Rajabhat University, 13th Floor, Rajabhat Memorial Building, Chiang Mai Rajabhat University (Wieng Bua Area), to exempt from registering for English language courses <u>at the doctoral level</u>. This is also to exempt from the basic English language knowledge test and to register for English language courses <u>at the master's level</u> as prescribed by the university.
