Recruitment of Pre-degree Program in Bachelor Level for Second Semester Academic Year 2024

Chiang Mai Rajabhat University will recruit persons to study in the pre-degree program. This is to support those who are studying at the junior high school/high school level or equivalent or any person who are interested to study some subjects in the bachelor's degree program of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University according to the interests and aptitude of the learners. Learners will receive credits for subjects in which they pass the exam and when entering to study in the bachelor's degree program at Chiang Mai Rajabhat University, they can transfer credits and grades. The university therefore announces recruitment of pre-degree program for second semester academic year 2024, the details are as follows.

1. Qualifications of applicants

- 1.1 Be a person who is studying at the junior high school/high school level or equivalent.
- 1.2 Be any person who is interested in the program.

2. Application Process

Apply via the website <https://creditbank.cmru.ac.th/pre-degree/> within the period in the activity calendar specified by the university with application fee of 200 Baht. Applicants can see the details from manual on the website.

3. Fees

3.1 Courses registration fees for the pre-degree program as per the table attached to this announcement or applicants can check additional details via the website

3.2 Learners registration fees for the pre-degree program is 500 Baht. The fee is collected only once and will be charged when learners would like to accumulate course credits and grades in the credit bank system of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University.

3.3 University fee is 500 Baht which is paid only for the enrolled semester.

4. Courses taught in the pre-degree program

The university has courses offered in the pre-degree program according to the table attached to this announcement.

5. Teaching and Learning Styles

The university conducts teaching and learning on Monday-Friday as a hybrid classroom. This refers to teaching and learning by attending regular classrooms at Chiang Mai Rajabhat University along with attending classes via online channels. Learners attend class according to the time period specified in the class schedule.

6. Benefits of studying in the pre-degree program

6.1 Learners who pass the exam can transfer course credits and grades when entering to study in the undergraduate program of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University without re-registering those courses.

6.2 Learners receive an academic report card from the pre-degree program.
